W. Rly. Transported 69 Thousand Tonnes Of Essential Commodities To Various Parts Of The Country



Ahmedabad, Western Railway's Parcel Express trains as well as goods trains continue to transport essential commodities to various parts of the country. In the wake of COVID-19, when other means of transport are restricted, Western Railway is well ensuring the supply of milk, medicines and other necessary products to different parts of the country through its various trains. It has also been fulfilling the responsibility of transporting essential items like medicines, medical equipment, foodgrainset in small parcel

sizes across the nation, as it has always been fully committed to the needs of its customers. In continuation to this, Train No 00913/00914 parcel special train which runs between Porbandar-Shalimar as notified earlier, will now have additional halt Bharuch, Ankleshwar, Gondia, Kharagpur, Panskura, Mechhada station in both directions, as per demand. According to a press release issued by Western Rly, since 23rd March to 2nd July, 2020, commodities weighing more than 69 thousand tonnes have been

transported by Western Rly through its 376 parcel special trains, which mainly included agricultural produce, medicines, fish, milk etc. The revenue generated through this transportation, has been approx Rs.22.15 crore. During this period, 52 milk special trains were run by Western Rly, with a load of more than 39 thousand tonnes and 100% utilization of the wagons, generating revenue of approx Rs.6.72 crore. Similarly,

316 Covid-19 special parcel trains with a load of more than 26,800 tonnes were also run to transport various essential commodities, for which the revenue earned was Rs 13.68 crore. In addition to this, 8 indented rakes carrying 3534 tonnes were also run with almost 100% utilization generating revenue of more than Rs 1.76 crore. During the lockdown period from 22nd March till 2nd July, 2020, total 8073 rakes of goods trains have been used by WR to supply essential commodities amounting to 16.67 million tonnes. 15,871 freight trains have been interchanged with other zonal railways, in which 7957 trains were handed over and 7914 trains taken over at different interchange points. 377 Millennium Parcel rakes of Parcel Vans / Railway Milk Tankers (RMTs) have been sent to different parts of the country to supply as per the demands of essential items such as milk powder, liquid

milk and other general consumer goods. WR has scheduled to run various timetable Parcel special trains during lockdown period to different parts of the country. One of these, one Parcel Special train departed on 3rd July, 2020 from Porbandar to Shalimar. The total loss of earnings over Western Railway on account of Corona Virus, has been over Rs 1567 crore, which includes Rs 227.99 crore for suburban section and Rs 1339.99 crore for non-suburban. In spite of this, resulting in cancellation of tickets till now, Western Railway has ensured to return refund amount of Rs. 361.69 crore. It's worth mentioning that in this refund amount, Mumbai division alone, has ensured refund of more than Rs 181.19 crore. Till now, 58.55 lakh passengers have cancelled their tickets over entire Western Railway & have received their refund amount accordingly.

WR Transported 16.87 Million Tonnes Through More Than 8168 Rakes Of Goods Trains



Ahmedabad, Despite complete lockdown imposed from 22nd March, 2020 and the current partial lockdown, Western Railway has done commendable work by loading 8168 rakes of goods trains till 3rd July, 2020, including various essential commodities such as POL - 893, Fertilizers - 1259, Salt - 458, Foodgrainset - 87, Cement - 548, Coal - 318, Containers - 4064 & General Goods - 39 rakes, amounting to 16.87 Million Tonnes to different states of the country, including North East region. In addition to this 378 rakes of Millennium Parcel Van and Milk Tank Wagons containing various essential commodities such as medicine, medical kits, frozen food, milk powder and liquid milk were loaded to Northern & North East region. Total 152328 Freight trains were interchanged with other Railways including 8040 trains handed over and 8014 trains taken over at different interchange points of Western Railway. During the period, important inward rakes such

as 1075 rakes of Jumbo, 581 rakes of BOXN and 470 rakes of BTPN were unloaded despite shortage of labour at various stations over Western Rly. According to a press release issued by Western Rly, since 23rd March to 3rd July, 2020, commodities weighing more than 69,600 tonnes have been transported by Western Rly through its 377 parcel special trains, which mainly included agricultural produce, medicines, fish, milk etc. The earnings generated through this transportation, has been approx Rs.22.22 crore. Eight police personnel, including a deputy superintendent of police, were gunned down last week at a village near Kanpur by the henchmen of Dubey. An accomplice of Dubey has been arrested, while the gangster is still at large. The Saamana editorial said that Dubey is said to have fled to neighbouring Nepal. Pointing to the porous border and current relations with Nepal, the editorial said,
